Bagi tujuan tersebut, Pengamal Perubatan warganegara Malaysia yang mempunyai Sijil Perakuan Amalan Tahunan semasa yang sah dengan alamat tempat mengamal utama di sektor swasta adalah layak untuk dicalonkan oleh pengamal perubatan warganegara Malaysia yang juga mempunyai Sijil Perakuan Amalan Tahunan semasa yang sah dengan alamat tempat amalan utama di sektor swasta bagi mengisi kekosongan tersebut.
