GUIDELINE FOR EXAMINATION FOR PROVISIONAL REGISTRATION

1. Pursuant to the Medical Act 1971, you are required to register with the Malaysian Medical Council (MMC) to practice medicine in Malaysia.
2. Pursuant to Sections 12 (1)(aa) of the Medical Act 1971, the Examination for Provisional Registration (EPR) is for medical graduates from universities not listed in the Second Schedule of the Medical Act 1971. Provision for EPR is entailed in the Medical (Settings of Examination for Provisional Registration) Regulations 2015.
3. Fee payable are as follows:
 - 3.1. Processing fee RM1000.00
 - 3.2. Theory Examination RM3000.00
 - 3.3. Clinical Examination RM3000.00
4. All applications are to be made via Medical Register Information and Technical System (MeRITS) at meritsmmc.moh.gov.my.
5. All foreign graduates are required to submit a verified medical degree and transcript via Primary Source Verification through Dataflow or Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates (ECFMG).
6. All documents should be certified according to the MMC Guideline for Document Verification. (Please refer the following link: <https://mmc.gov.my/Guideline-doc-verify.pdf>).
7. Should your printed names in any of the submitted documents differ, you are required to submit a Statutory Declaration (stating the name as on the identity card is the same individual, for foreigners, the name as in the passport).
8. If the original documents are not in either Bahasa Malaysia or English, you need to submit translated versions (original and not copy) in either Bahasa Malaysia or English along with certified copies of the document in its original language. Translated documents are only acceptable if carried out by qualified translators such as Institut Terjemahan dan Buku Malaysia (ITBM) or Officers of appropriate Embassy.
9. EPR will be held twice in a year (circa March and September for that calendar year) and closing dates for such application will be ONE (1) month prior to the exam date. Announcement for the dates will be available in the MMC website.
10. All applicants are required to pass the Theory Examination before being allowed to sit for the Clinical Examination.
11. Registration will only be issued upon passing the EPR.

Applications Using Medical Register Information and Technical System (MeRITS)

1. All applicants must upload the documents and pay a processing fee RM1000.
2. All applicants will get a letter to confirm that they are allowed to sit for the Theory Exam.
3. All applicants must choose their preferred session for Theory Exam (March/September).
4. A fee of RM3000 for each attempt is required to sit for the Theory Exam.
5. Announcement of the exam dates will be available on the MMC website.
6. Upon passing the Theory Exam, applicants can apply for the Clinical Examination.
7. All applicants must choose their preferred session for Clinical Exam (April/October).
8. All applicants will be notified on the details of the Clinical Exam via email. Fee of RM3000 for each attempt of the Clinical Exam will be collected by the conducting institution.
9. Results for the EPR will be notified through MeRITS.

Format for Theory Paper

1. All questions (English) are in the form of one-best answer (OBA) type of question.
2. Paper 1: Medical based (60 Questions) – 90 minutes
3. Paper 2: Surgical based (60 Questions) – 90 minutes
4. Passing marks is 50%.

Format for Clinical Component

1. It will be based on OSCE form – with both manned and unmanned stations.
2. Detailed information about the Clinical Exam will be notified via email.
