



## **Important Announcement: Application Submission Policy**

The Malaysian Medical Council (MMC), established under the Medical Act 1971, is the statutory body responsible for the registration of medical practitioners and the regulation of medical practice in Malaysia.

It has come to the MMC's attention that individuals who are not registered medical practitioners (RMPs) have been accessing applicants' accounts and submitting applications on their behalf. This practice gravely undermines the integrity of the application process, jeopardizing the accuracy, reliability, and completeness of the information provided. Therefore, the MMC categorically prohibits such actions and strictly mandates that all applicants and RMPs personally manage their submissions and inquiries, ensuring full accountability, transparency, and compliance.

In strict compliance with the Medical Act 1971 and MMC's policy, **all applications must be submitted directly by the applicants/RMPs themselves. The MMC will not, under any circumstances, entertain or engage in any third-party communications regarding applications.**

**Non-compliance with this policy will adversely affect the applicant/RMP's application. The MMC assumes no responsibility or liability for any consequences or repercussions arising from such non-compliance.**
