



SPECIALIST REGISTRATION VIA SARAWAK MEDICAL COMMITTEE

On 22nd October 2024, the Malaysian Medical Council (MMC) established the Sarawak Medical Committee (SMC) to help address the ongoing shortage of medical specialists in Sarawak. The SMC provides a dedicated and focused pathway for the evaluation of specialists who wish to serve exclusively in the state. This includes specialists whose qualifications are not listed in the Fourth Schedule of the Medical Act 1971.

The SMC will evaluate and recommend both Malaysian and foreign-trained specialists for registration to practise in Sarawak, ensuring that assessments remain aligned to national standards while recognising Sarawak's unique healthcare needs. The MMC remains steadfast in its commitment to patient safety, equitable access to healthcare, and improving health outcomes for the people of Sarawak through the timely deployment of qualified practitioners. PENDAFTARAN PAKAR MELALUI JAWATANKUASA PERUBATAN SARAWAK

Pada 22 Oktober 2024, Majlis Perubatan Malaysia (MMC) telah menubuhkan Jawatankuasa Perubatan Sarawak (SMC) bagi menangani kekurangan pakar perubatan yang berterusan di negeri Sarawak. SMC menyediakan satu laluan penilaian pakar yang ingin berkhidmat secara eksklusif di negeri tersebut, termasuk pakar yang kelayakannya tidak disenaraikan dalam Jadual Keempat Akta Perubatan 1971.

SMC akan menilai dan mengesyorkan pakar bertauliah dari dalam dan luar negara untuk pendaftaran berkhidmat di Sarawak, dengan memastikan proses penilaian selaras dengan standard kebangsaan sambil mengambil kira keperluan perubatan Sarawak. MMC kekal komited terhadap keselamatan pesakit, akses perubatan yang saksama, serta usaha meningkatkan tahap kesihatan rakyat Sarawak melalui penempatan pakar berkelayakan dengan lebih saksama.
