GUIDELINES FOR MAINTAINING IN THE SECOND SCHEDULE

1. LOCAL INSTITUTIONS

- 1.1. Includes public and private higher education institutions (IPTA/IPTS) registered in Malaysia and accredited by the **Malaysian Qualifications Agency (MQA)** or licensed by the **Ministry of Higher Education (MOHE)**.
- 1.2. Recognition in the Second Schedule will be maintained **according to the accreditation/licensing duration** granted by the relevant authorities as above.
- 1.3. In cases where Malaysian Medical Council (MMC) no longer recognises the institution, **de-recognition will apply prospectively**, affecting future student intakes only.

2. FOREIGN INSTITUTIONS

Criteria for continued listing:

- 2.1. Medical programmes must be recognised by the relevant authorities in the home country (inquiry through embassy).
- 2.2. Listed in the **World Directory of Medical Schools (WDOMS)** or **World Federation for Medical Education (WFME)**.
- 2.3. Presence of medical practitioners employed or working in Malaysia from the listed institutions.
- 2.4. Verified editorial or structural changes to the degree/institution name.

3. DURATION OF CONTINUED RECOGNITION

- 3.1. **Local Institutions:** Follows the accreditation/licensing period granted by Malaysian Qualifications Agency (MQA), Ministry of Higher Education (MOHE), or Malaysian Medical Council (MMC).
- 3.2. **Foreign Institutions:** Subject to **review every five (5) years**.

4. APPLICATION AND RECOGNITION PROCESS

- 4.1. **Local Institutions:** Based on the standard procedures of accreditation and licensing by relevant authorities.
- 4.2. **Foreign Institutions:** Institutions are reviewed every 5 years.
